Divisions:

Leadline- (LL) Riders can be any age but must be on a lead line. Youth- Riders must be under 18yo and will only be asked to walk/trot. Riders may be accompanied in the ring by an adult but not on a lead line.

Open- (O) Riders can be any age and will be asked to walk/trot/canter.

Class Descriptions:

Showmanship- Handlers will be judged on their ability to present the horse to the judge. The horse is not judged in this class except as it pertains to the handlers fitting of the animal. Miniature horses, ponies, donkeys etc. are welcome in this class.

English Equitation- Riders will be judged on their overall turnout, use of aids and horsemanship while under English tack.

Western Equitation- Riders will be judged on their overall turnout, use of aids and horsemanship while under western tack.

Clover Leaf Barrels-

Potato Race- Riders will be given two potatoes. Two barrels will be set up at the far end of the ring with buckets on top of them. Riders will ride down to the first barrel, drop one potato in the bucket, ride to the next barrel, put the second potato in the bucket and ride back to the finish.

Egg & Spoon- Each rider will get an egg on a spoon. Riders will be asked to walk and trot. The last person with their egg balancing on their spoon wins.

Ribbon Race- Riders will pick a partner, who will ride next to each other holding a ribbon between them. The pairs will be asked to walk, trot, change direction, halt etc. Pairs will be eliminated if they break or drop their ribbon. The last pair holding their ribbon will win.

Obstacle Trail Class- There will be various obstacles and maneuvers that riders will complete in a specific order. Riders will be judged on how their horse completes each obstacle and any ties will be broken by time.

The Miniature Horse Class will be in hand and the obstacles will be adjusted to accommodate miniature equine partners.
